

National Museum of Korea

국립중앙박물관

National Museum of Korea is one of the largest museums in Korea which takes its visitors on a walk through the history of the country from prehistorical period to the 20th century. The museum is based on reimagination of elegance in simplicity – the ethos behind Korean traditional architecture – and creates beautiful harmony with the surrounding natural landscape including mountains, forest and ponds. National Museum of Korea showcases over 120,000 pieces of relics in its 6 permanent exhibition rooms; special exhibitions themed around a variety of themes; and exhibitions for young and promising audience at the Children's Museum. Further, the museum provides friendly guide and convenient facility to use for international visitors as well. National Museum of Korea offers spaces for academic conference or events including the main auditorium with 416 seats, small assembly hall with 214 seats and lecture room with 100 seats. Furthermore, at a restaurant within the facility, visual and audio equipment is well furnished allowing conferences to hold presentations and lectures which include dining options. And an outdoor space, Open Plaza provides venue for large-scale events.

Oil Tank Culture Park

문화비축기지

Oil Tank Culture Park is a culture park that had the former oil depot with restricted public access for over four decades transform into a landmark of urban regeneration. There are 5 oil reservoir tanks that previously reserved oil for Seoul residents to use about a month, and 4 of them today are used for performance venue and lecture rooms open to the public. One of the tanks, built by reusing interior and exterior materials disassembled from former oil tanks, functions as a community center with a cafeteria, a round-shaped meeting room, and multi-purpose lecture room. Rather than setting limits in usage, Oil Tank Culture Park chooses to get the most out of what it has for a variety of uses and events including lecture, exhibition and performance. In addition, at the Culture Plaza opened at the center of space measuring 140,000m², the size of 22 soccer fields, larger-scale events, workshops and festive events can be organized and hosted.

Samcheonggak is the place where visitors can touch, smell and feel Korean traditional culture. One of the monumental sites that held a banquet after Red Cross Korea Conference to celebrate the joint communique of July 4, 1972, Samcheonggak has been favored as a venue for state dinners and international conferences. In addition, the venue continues its high reputation as a global tourist attraction with a restaurant serving Korean traditional cuisine, café serving Korean traditional tea and spaces to experience traditional culture.

Samcheonggak houses 6 units of *hanok*, Korean traditional housing, in various sizes. And it is capable of providing venues for hosting a vast variety of events ranging from smaller-sized seminars, company events to international events. The largest *hanok*, Ilhwadang can be used for many purposes as it can offer an indoor space for performances and a spacious front yard. You may also consider planning a special banquet at the front yard, featuring the majestic scenery of Mount Bukhansan as a backdrop. In addition, you can also find a Korean restaurant serving fine Korean cuisine and a café, Dawon that serves rich-flavored Korean traditional tea.

This explicitly hints at the pursuit and aspiration of COSMO 40 - “unbounded inspiring space” and thus offers visitors an opportunity to step out of their comfort zone, explore and find inspiration.

What was once packed with grandiose machinery has now turned into a space of possibility where anyone can experiment. The main hall connecting the 1st and the 2nd floor is an extensive space with a ceiling measuring 8m that is capable of hosting larger-sized exhibitions and events. Hoist Hall on the 3rd floor, on the other hand, has a ceiling height of 12m, and can be used independently for hosting and organizing events. Curtain Room on the 4th floor is adequate for lectures and meetings.





Further, Nurimaru APEC House is surrounded by Haeundae Beach to the south, and camelia and pine tree forest to the north and receives high praise as an international conference venue with a good harmony between tradition, modernity and the beauty of nature.

As well as APEC Summit, Nurimaru APEC House has been selected as a venue for numerous international events, including the 1st Mekong-Republic of Korea Summit in 2019. The conference room on the 2nd floor is adequately designed for international conferences, academic conferences and banquets, while the outdoor garden, Jayumadang is suitable for performances and banquets.





Jeju Folk Village

제주민속촌

Jeju Folk Village has been designed to preserve cultural heritage of Jeju Island. Inspired from the island at around 1890s, rigorous research and historical search had been conducted before cultural and historical aspects, and everyday lives of the island were reproduced in Jeju Folk Village. 100 units of traditional housing in which local residents had actually lived in the past were relocated for exhibition in different sections including Mountain Village, Mid-mountain Village and Fishing Village. Besides, visitors can experience Korean traditional play at Play Ground; try local food at Folk Market; and take a tour around filming sites. Inside the village, traditional performance is showcased 3 times a day. Furthermore, the land as vast as 157,100m² is landscaped beautifully with local species of trees and flowers to welcome its visitors with different scenery every season.

What can be deemed as a village that can present unique scenery of Jeju Island, Jeju Folk Village has had extensive experience in hosting international events. At the former government office located at the center of the village, Jeju Yeongmun, you can plan and host a variety of events including state visit, international conference and company events.
